

Guarding Against Holiday Fraud

Digital convenience may also come hand in hand with potential risks. Zelle is a convenient way to send and receive money. While it’s a secure method for trusted transactions, it’s essential to remember there is no fraud protection once a payment is authorized. We recommend using Zelle only with people you trust, like friends, family or others you know, like your babysitter or neighbor.

In addition, Zelle doesn’t offer purchase protection, which may be risky for transactions, such as online purchases or sales. In these situations, it’s safer to explore a different payment method.
